Environmental Remediation - Management

- Developed program to manage 80 plus sites (\$10-\$25MM annually) with limited staff using a partnering program with key service providers.
- Evolved technology implementation using innovative approaches to focus the portfolio and manage cost/risks. This involved selecting smaller sites with favorable regulatory and low risk receptors to try innovative technologies that might be viable for widespread use throughout the portfolio. This included Oxidant Injection, Bio-Augmentation and Nutrient Addition, Horizontal Air Sparging, Sparging Free Product and Sparging Fractured Rock.
- Developed manual of procedures and guidelines to implement work improving consistency and forming the basis for continuous improvement. This address compliance, permitting, operations and maintenance, asset protection, project management, property access tools, contractor safety, technology implementation and training.
- Developed Peer review process and Technology Support Groups to focus remedial efforts. These reviews were instrumental in ensuring that sound decisions were being made at critical stages of a project, using a “fresh eyes” approach. The Technology Support Groups assembles experts from several large consulting firms to focus technology implementation using a combination of the best practices from this group of firms.
- Served as lead technical resource in more than 12 insurance recovery suits recovering over \$60MM from relic insurance coverage (1965 – 1978).
- Lead environmental resource in more than 12 lawsuits involving contaminant impacts to property. This developed a focused documentation program to minimize problems due to legal scrutiny.
